

# Welcome to Danderyd

Below you can see several activities aimed at those who are new to Danderyd. These activities are run by volunteers, either independently or in collaboration with Danderyd Municipality. A volunteer is someone who chooses to engage in nonprofit work without receiving payment. They do not work for the municipality but do this in their free time to welcome you and help you get the best possible start. Everyone is welcome to participate in the activities, and everything is free of charge.

## WELCOME CENTER

- **Time:** Tuesdays from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM
- **Location:** Danderyd Municipality, Mörby C
- **Info:** At the welcome center, you can ask any questions. A volunteer can help you register yourself or your child for an activity such as football, swimming lessons, gymnastics, or basketball. You can also get help with reading letters, submitting applications, or receiving information about Danderyd. We can book an interpreter if needed.

## MEETING POINT DANDERYD

- **Time:** Every Thursday from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
- **Location:** Edsviksvägen 1d, a 5-minute walk from Mörby Centrum
- **Info:** The meeting point is for socializing and practicing Swedish, both for adults and children. Children can also receive help with their homework. Sandwiches, drinks and fruits are provided for free.

Children are warmly welcome at the meeting point, but please remember that as a guardian, you are responsible for them while attending.

## LANGUAGE CAFÉ – Practice Your Swedish!

Everyone is welcome, whether you are completely new to Sweden and only know a few words of Swedish or have studied the language for a longer time. Here, you can practice Swedish with volunteers, and if they have time, they can also help you with your Swedish homework. Children are welcome too, but you are responsible for them.

- **Time:** Tuesdays from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM
- **Location:** The library, next to the municipality office, Mörby Centrum

- **Are you on parental leave?** Are you at home with a baby under one year old? You can bring your child to all activities! It is important to practice Swedish even when you are on parental leave. Come to the “Welcome Center,” and we will inform you about activities available for parents on leave.
